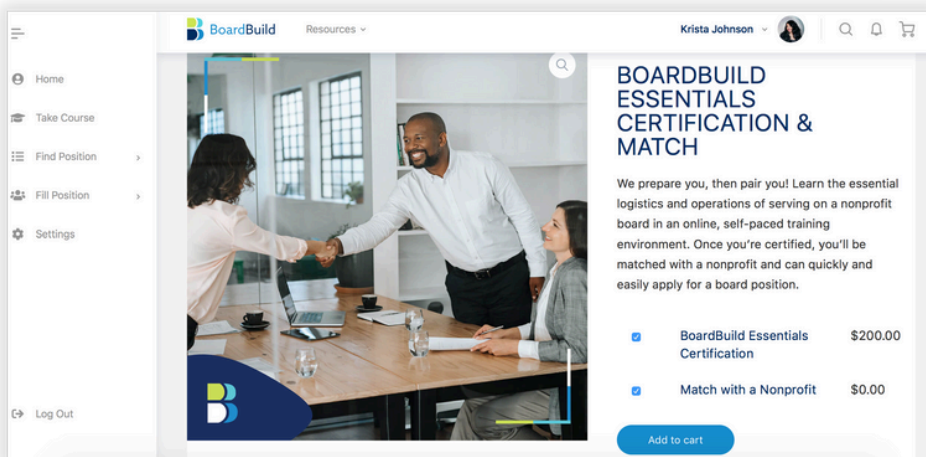
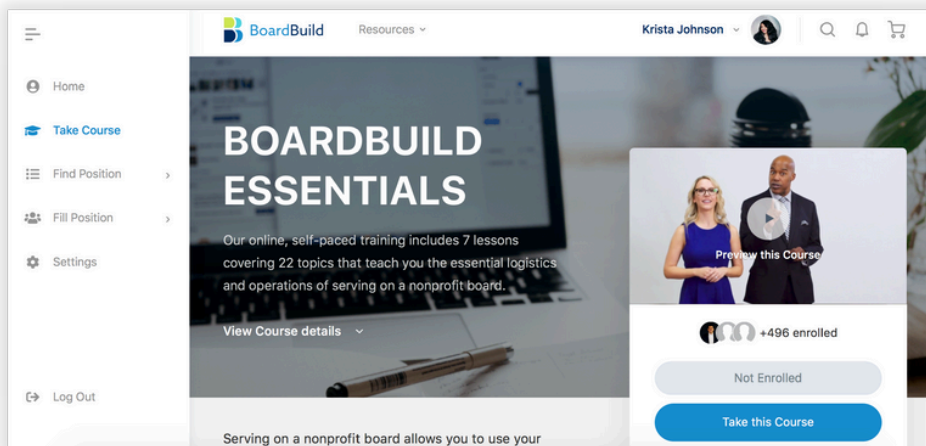

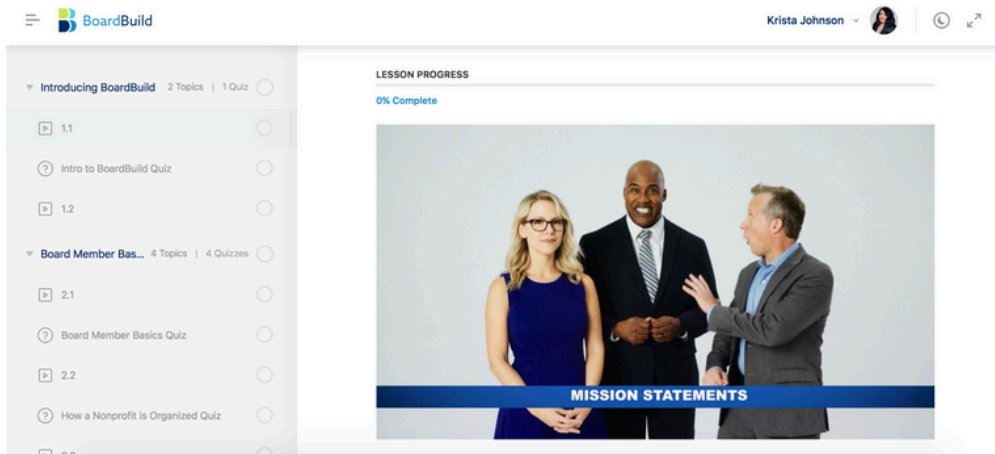


Select "Match with a "Nonprofit" to be connected with nonprofits looking for your passions, skills, and expertise. Add both to cart and complete your purchase.



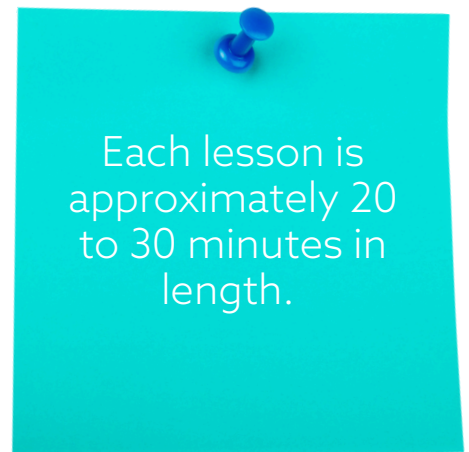
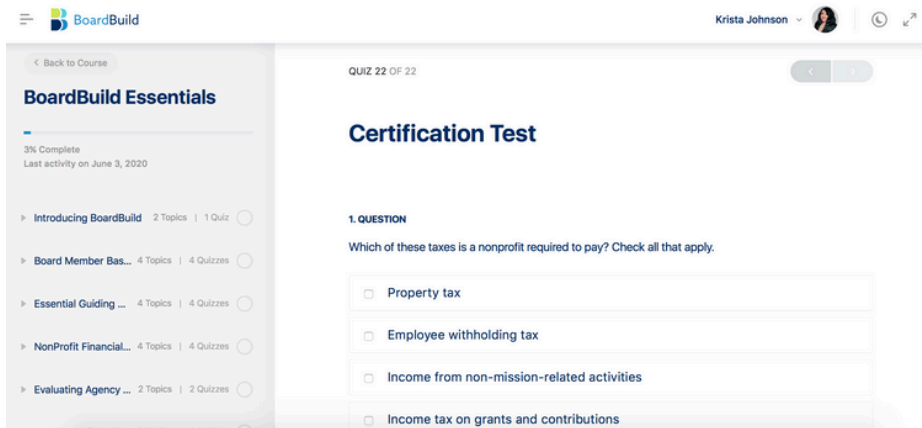
Step #3: View courses & complete quizzes

In order to be correctly matched with a nonprofit organization, you must complete your profile. Fill in all required information.

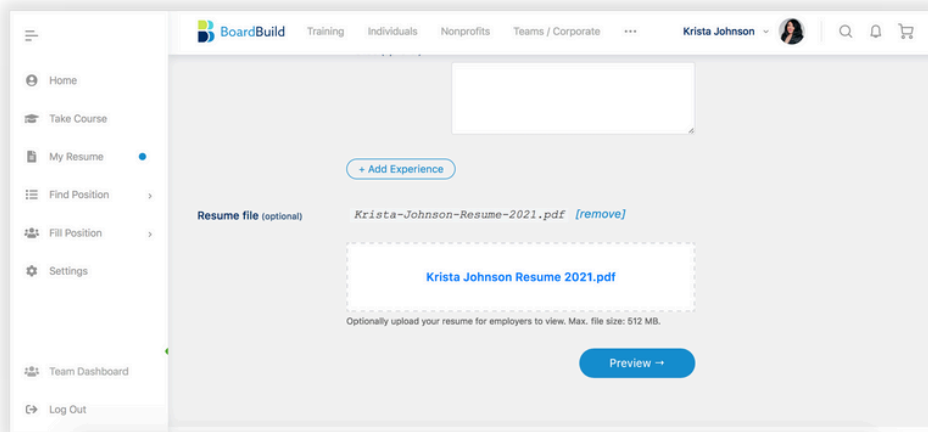
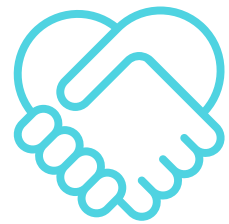
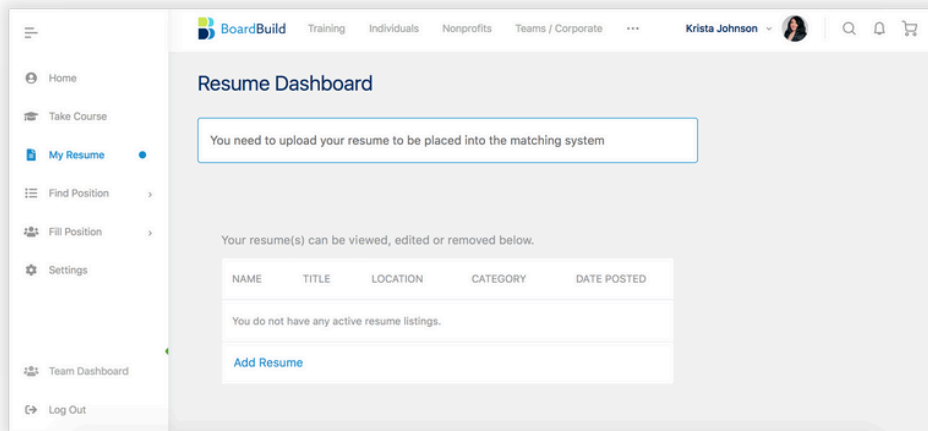


Answering the diversity and inclusion questions allows us to match you with a nonprofit who is seeking your unique point of view and rich life experiences.
